In accordance with the Federal EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), all public and private schools in the United States are required to inspect their facilities for asbestos. An additional requirement of the regulations is that parents and staff are to be informed that the inspection was done.

The Ogdensburg City School District facilities have been inspected for both friable (crumbles easily) and non-friable materials which contain asbestos. Friable asbestos has been found in an area at Ogdensburg Free Academy. The situation does not pose a health risk at this time.

Non-friable asbestos materials were found in various areas in the building. The situation does not pose a health risk at this time and we are carrying on periodic inspections to insure that there is no release of asbestos fibers.

The record of the inspection, drawings showing the locations of the friable and non-friable materials and a copy of the management plan are in the Management Services Office and available for your inspection. The next inspection is scheduled for February 2019.
